Safe Transportation of Food Responsibility

Due to Indiana State Guidelines, a Safe Transportation of Food form must be signed, dated, and maintained in each child's CMO record. Please read through the following information and stop by the office with questions or concerns.

All lunches brought to CMO must be in a clean, insulated, and sanitizable container. Upon arriving to CMO, please put your child's lunch in the designated refrigerator if you arrive prior to 8:30 am. If you arrive after 8:30 am, continue to place your child's lunch in the appropriate classroom lunch tote and we will place it in the refrigerator for you. All lunches will be maintained at a minimum of 41 degrees. Remember, we do not heat lunches!

I will provide food for my child. I take full responsibility for the safety of the food during preparation, storage, and transportation to CMO for meeting the needs of my child.
